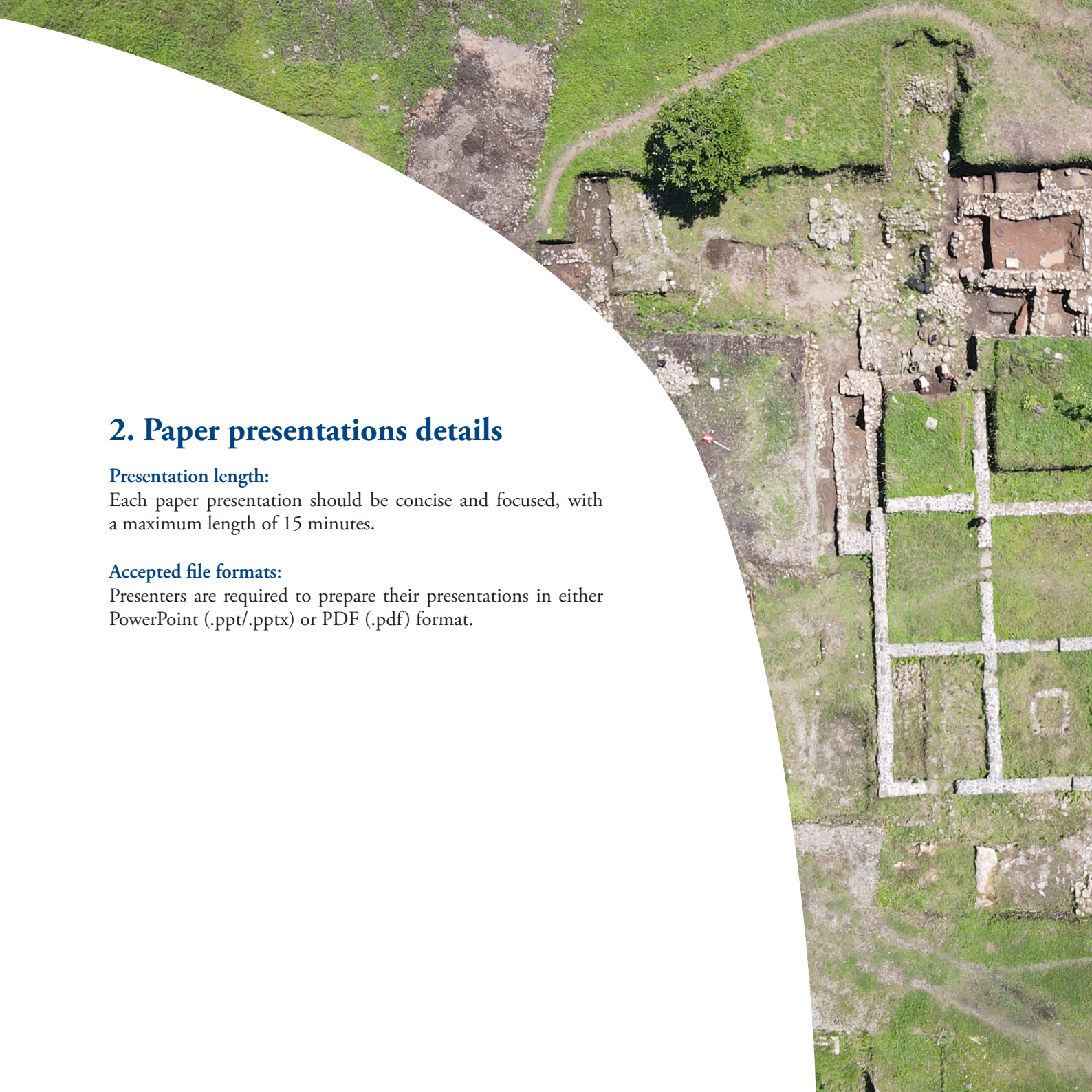
## 2. Paper presentations details

### Poster size and orientation:

All scientific posters should be A0 size (841mm x 1189mm) and in portrait orientation.

#### **Thursday (12.09):**

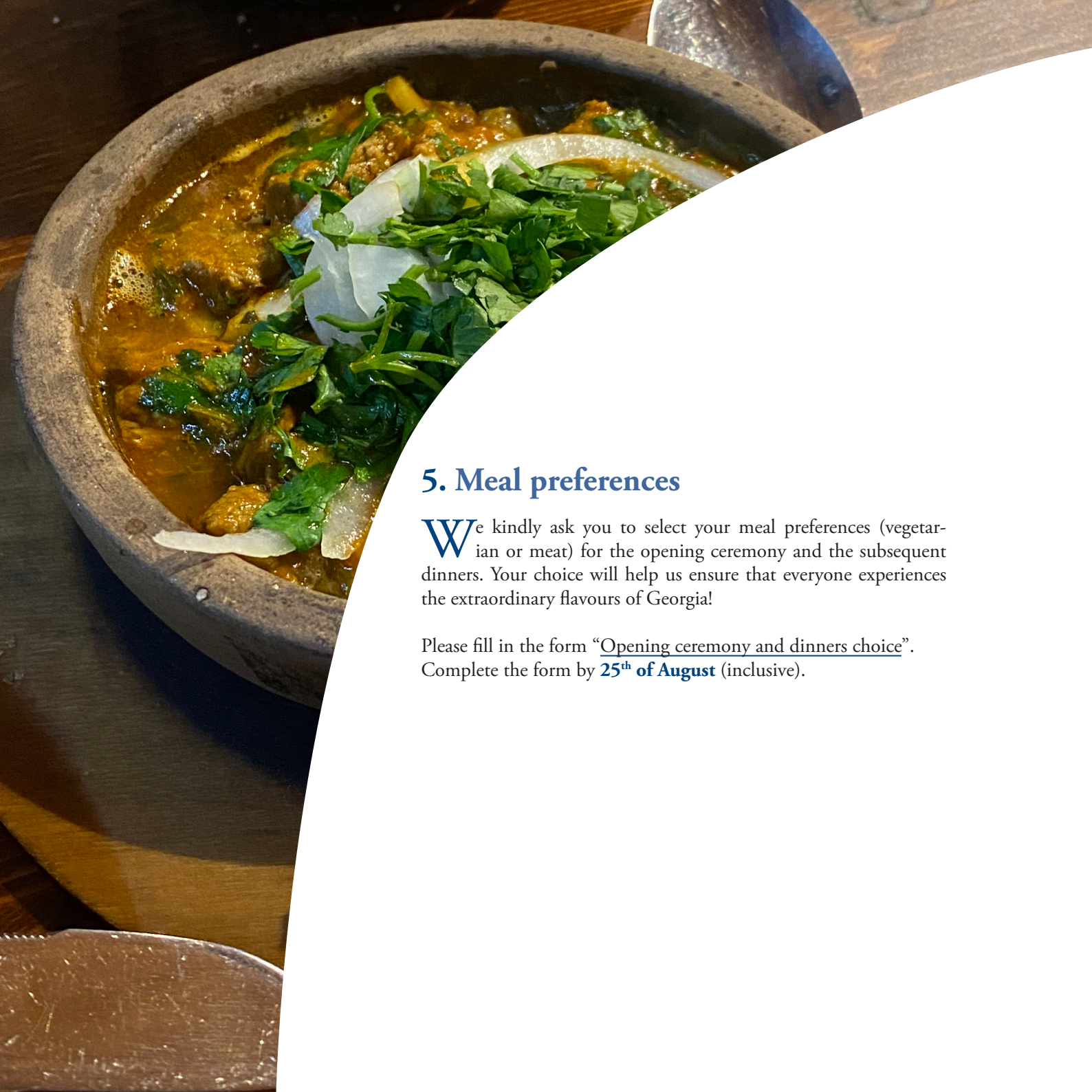

## **6. Wi-Fi connection**

### **Internet access at the Congress:**

Wi-Fi will be available throughout the congress venue at the university. Upon arrival, you will receive the necessary password information to connect. This will allow you to stay connected and access any online resources you may need during the event.

### **Purchasing a local SIM card:**

For those who prefer mobile internet access, you can purchase a local SIM card upon arrival at the Batumi/Kutaisi/Tbilisi airport. Several providers offer competitive rates, and prepaid SIM cards can be used immediately after activation. We recommend this option because roaming in Georgia is very expensive.
